



What are Hero Notifications?

Hero can send automatic emails to alert the parent of their student's behavior.

Who Receives the Email?

The guardian email address on file in Hero, sent from your SIS. The guardian does not need a Hero account to receive email notifications.

How Often Do They Receive the Email?

The email is sent immediately after that specific behavior is tracked, but you can customize it to fit your needs. We recommend setting these notifications to DEFAULT, meaning every time the behavior is tracked, but you have the flexibility to adjust that setting if desired.

What Does the Email Say?

The message is highly customizable. Many schools provide a short message about the behavior, and a brief explanation of their discipline policy. The email can also include the behavior history that will list the actions and action dates earned. Feel free to copy and paste the templates provided.

Select "Notification Center" to get started.

Hold a Weekly or Monthly Raffle Drawing for Students and Staff

- Students earn entries into the raffle drawing just by being recognized for positive behavior in Hero.
- Use the Daily Activity Report and filter for all positive behaviors, or a specific behavior.
- Export to a CSV and select a random number(s) to identify your winner(s).

If students are not showing up to do the work, that's just the symptom. That's not the problem. It could be that a student didn't have a computer or their hotspot broke. We [educators] have a responsibility to dig into these barriers to learning early on and Hero helps us do just that.

Monitor these reports on a regular basis to intervene early.

Daily Activity Report	Accrued Records Report	Student Behavior History
View this report weekly or bi-weekly to view schoolwide behavior trends. Select the "Graph" tab to generate a graph of your Hero behaviors for that date range. Identify areas of success and areas for improvement.	View this report weekly or bi-weekly to identify students in need of interventions for missing live sessions or missing assignments. Filter for a broader date range for each specific behavior. Sort within the "Count" column to identify students with an excessive count of your accountability codes.	Once you've identified your students in need of interventions, select their hyperlinked name in the report, or select the magnifying glass icon to search for that student. Select the "Behavior History Tab" to view a running log of their Hero behaviors. This log may help bring to light trends for this particular student that may help determine how to apply interventions to support this student.

Optional: <u>Auto assign actions</u> as part of your behavior flowchart. Students and parents can view their assigned actions in notifications and the app. Users can use the <u>Compliance Report</u> to ensure actions are completed as part of your intervention plan.
